Math -Students will be able to identify and write numbers 0-20. Students will be able to count 1-75.

Science - Students will be able to identify and discuss hibernation.

First Grade Objectives

Reading: Students will work on these comprehension skills: prediction, retell, characters, and making connections with the story. Students will identify and read word families with long e words ate and ike. Students will identify and use compound words. **Sight words:** Continue to practice sight words. **Writing:** Students will answer a writing prompt with multiple sentences. **Spelling words:** gave rake hike like cake bake bite Dave time

Math: Students will practice math facts to 20 for fluency. Practice +8 and +9

Second Grade Objectives

Reading: Students will be able to identify facts and details.

Math: Students will develop strategies to solve problems involving dollar bills and coins.

Spelling: Students will be able to spell and read words with *r-controlled vowels: er, ir, and ur.*

Spelling Words: serve, curl, skirt, nurse, person, purse, dirt, turn, curb, turtle, her, birth

Writing: Students will be working on writing informative/explanatory texts in which they include a topic and facts/details.

Reading: Students will practice writing imperative and exclamatory sentences. Students will identify consonant blends in the given passages.

Math: Students will practice place value ones, tens, hundreds and thousands.

Writing: Students will practice writing three detailed sentences in their journal while using the correct parts of a five star sentence.
