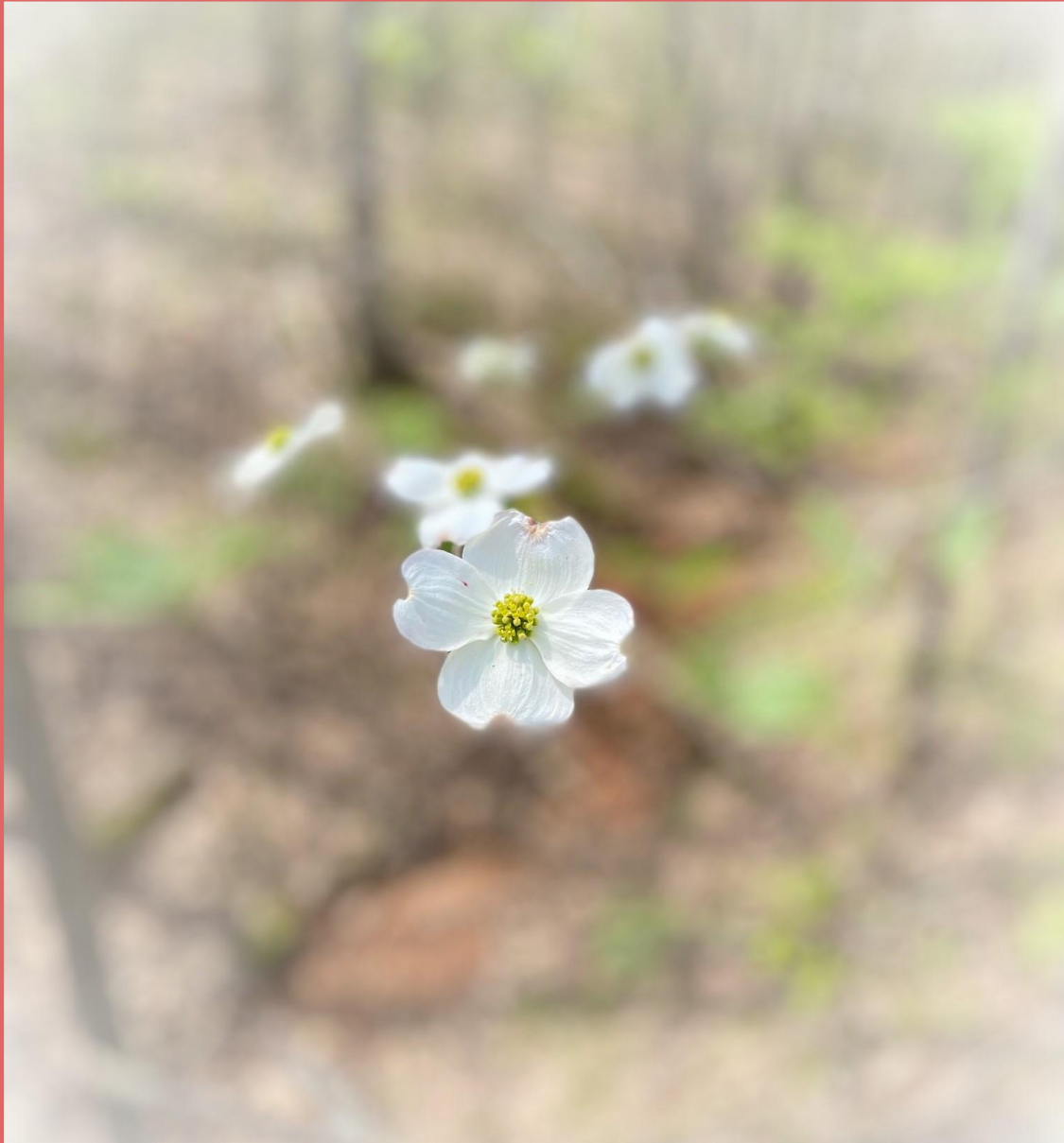

## Objectives for week of April 2, 2024

### Kindergarten Objectives

**Reading** - Students will be able to identify ALL beginning blends and ALL digraphs.

Students will be able to identify already learned sight words (41) **I, am, a, in, be, no, the, it, can, me, to, and, is, see, did, at, big, said, the, like, has, up, we, play, make, get, was, what, not, my, you, he, look, run, she, of, here, go, are, do, come, for.**

Students will be able to identify verbs, nouns, and adjectives; ALL reading comprehension skills (i.e. plot, sequence, character, setting).

**Writing** - Students will be able to write their first and LAST name. Students will be able to independently write a five star sentence - 1. Capital letter; 2. Finger spaces; 3. Punctuation; 4. Written neatly; 5. Makes sense

**Math** - Students will be able to identify subtraction sentences, subtraction sign, equals sign, difference.

Students will be able to subtract two numbers up to 5. Students will be able to count **1-100**.

**Science** - Students will be able to identify living and nonliving things.

### First Grade Objectives

**Reading:** Students will work on these comprehension skills: prediction, retell, characters, and making connections with the story. Students will identify and read words with igh. **Sight words:** Continue to practice sight words. **Writing:** Students will answer a writing prompt with multiple sentences. **Spelling words:** four for name so house read book live may she **Math:** Students will work on comparing and ordering numbers **Practice +8 and +9** We will have math fact drills.

### Second Grade Objectives

**Reading:** Students will be able to identify facts and opinions.

**Math:** Students will be able to choose appropriate tools to estimate, measure, and compare lengths using customary units (inches, feet, and yards).

**Spelling:** Students will be able to spell and read words with vowel patterns ou, ow, oi, and oy.

**Spelling Words:** around, out, gown, sound, flower, howl, toy, noise, royal, moist, coil, cow.

**Writing:** Students will write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section.

### Mrs Miller's Resource Room Objectives

#### First grade

**Reading :** Students will practice the short / o / sound words in the story and identify declarative sentences.

**Math:** Students will practice adding and subtracting within 20.

**Writing:** Students will practice writing five star sentences and writing simple sentences.

#### Second Grade

**Reading:** Students will practice r- controlled vowels er, ir and or and identify plurals and singular nouns.

**Math:** Students will practice adding and subtracting within 20.

**Writing :** Students will practice writing five detailed sentences in their journal while using the correct parts of a five star sentence to make a paragraph.

**April Cougar Connections: Students will identify the character trait: PATIENCE. Patience is being able to wait for something while having a positive attitude and without getting upset.**
