# OBJECTIVES for the week of September 30, 2024

**Kindergarten:** Reading: Fire Prevention and Community Helpers Letters: Zz Ff Ll Ii  
Comprehension Skill: Main Idea. Writing: Review writing lines. Skyline, middle line, and ground line.  
Tracing/writing first names and letters (Zz Ff Ll Ii)  
Math: Identify and write numbers 1-5

**First Grade/McCloy Resource Room:** **Reading:** Students will work on these comprehension skills this week visualize, retell, characters, and making connections with the story. Students will blend and segment sounds. Students will decode words with short o. **Sight words:** fly, on, put, all, the, thank, too, orange, pink, purple **Writing:** Students will write a complete sentence. **Spelling words** hot, dot, pot, job, mom, mop, top, hop, lot, sob, got, not **Math:** Students will work on 2D and 3D shapes.

**Second Grade:** **Reading:** Students will be able to identify Main Idea.

**Math:** Students will find the total number of objects in situations involving equal groups of objects.. Students will learn about using arrays in repeated addition.

**Spelling:** Students will be able to spell and read words with long vowels VCe.

**Spelling Words:** race, space, nose, page, blaze, fine, huge, size, rice, mice, vote, late

**Music:** Students will understand and exhibit a steady beat. Students will sing using “SO” and “MI” in songs and in practice. Students will learn “echo” songs and use them in “follow the leader” games. Students will learn movement and motion with music.

**PE:** Students will complete fitness testing as well as learn basics/play kickball.

## **Mrs. Miller's Resource Room:**

### **First Grade**

Reading: Students will practice reading and identifying simple sentences in a passage.

Math: Students will practice using ten frames while using addition and subtraction in the problem.

Writing: Students will practice writing five-star sentences and writing the letter Dd and Ll.

### **Second Grade**

Reading: Students will practice consonant blends and predicates in a sentence.

Math: Students will practice subtraction while using a number line or a ten frame.

Writing: Students will practice writing five detailed sentences in their journal while using the correct parts of a five-star sentence and practicing writing a three-sentence paragraph.
