**Spelling:** Students will be able to spell two syllable words with long vowel patterns.

## Third Grade Objectives

**Reading:** Students will read Symphony of Whales and will use generalizations in reading texts..

Students will use, ask, and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of text. Students will learn about whales in the story A Symphony of Whales.

**Writing:** Students will use able to use capitalization, punctuation, and spelling patterns when writing a complete sentence. Students produce, expand, and rearrange complete simple and compound sentences.

**Math:** Students will understand how to read and write unit fractions for equal-sized parts of a region. Students will use a fraction to represent multiple copies of a unit fraction.

**Science:** Students will learn about whales and their habitats. Students will learn how people can help endangered animals. Students will be able to make a claim about the merit of a solution to a problem caused when the environment changes and how those changes affect the types of plants, animals, and people that live there.

**Social Studies:** Students will investigate and research myths.

**Spelling:** Students will correctly spell words with vowel patterns *-ou*, *-ow*, *-oi*, and *-oy*.
