Dear Parents, Legal Guardians, and Students:

Enrollment for Summer School is now open for any Kingston High School student entering grades 9-12 for the 2022-2023 school year. Summer School will be held virtually this year and will begin on Tuesday, May 31st and end on Friday June, 24th. All high school students enrolling for Summer School must attend orientation in the high school cafeteria on May 31st. Orientation will begin at 7:45 AM and should only last about an hour to make sure your student is enrolled in the classes they have selected, are able to navigate the virtual program successfully, and receive contact information if troubleshooting or assistance is needed. Once your student has completed orientation they are free to leave.

In the event your student doesn't have internet service and wants to attend Summer School, then a staff member will be on campus each day if they need to attend in person. Summer School hours for the high school begins at 7:45 AM and ends at 3:10 PM. Students should not be dropped off prior to 7:15 AM, but should be at school by 7:40 AM if they are needing to attend in person. Breakfast and lunch will be served in the elementary cafeteria free of charge for any student enrolled in summer school and breakfast will begin at 7:15 AM.

For students needing transportation, there will be four bus routes. We will be using bus routes similar to those of the regular school year. See the attached bus route sheet to determine which bus your student would ride for Summer School.

Applications are now available and can be picked up in the high school office or printed off of the school website at www.kingston.k12.mo.us. All applications must be turned into the high school office by Monday May, 23rd. If you have any questions or need further assistance, then please call the high school office at 573-438-4982 x3.

The Kingston High School Summer School Virtual Program is web-based and accessible anywhere through an internet connection. A Kingston K-14 staff member will be available on campus to help students needing assistance navigating through the program and for those students who don't have internet access and need to attend in person. Students who have internet access will work from home and weekly phone calls to parents (when concerns are present) will be conducted periodically during the virtual summer school session to ensure students are making adequate progress.

You may obtain up to 1 full credit in the Virtual Summer School Session (May 31st - June 24th). Courses are either one semester (0.5) or two semesters (1.0) in length. Please circle the desired course(s):

BASIC RULES OF OUR SCHOOL

Students will be expected to follow all school rules at Summer School. The Kingston K-14 School District's Discipline policy is listed in the student handbook located on our school website. Since the Summer School program is entirely voluntary and free to the students, poor student performance and/or behavior will result in dismissal from the program. The classroom teacher has complete control over a student's continued participation in the program. Teachers will call parents concerning any behavior which detracts from a student's ability to learn in the classroom. More than one phone call concerning misbehavior or poor performance will result in that student's dismissal from Summer School.

In addition to behavior, I understand the expectations for course completion. In the event I am not progressing in my course(s) or do not complete the courses by June 24th, 2022, I will be dropped from the course(s) and not earn/ obtain credit. I also understand that it could reflect poorly on my transcript.

2022 Summer School Bus Routes

Route A Bus 6 -

Bus 6 will leave school at 6:30 and turn south on Highway 21 to Pat Daly. Pat Daly to Sugar Loaf 1st stop and pick up at (6:40). Turn around & come back down on Pat Daly to Sour Hill. Pick up through Sour Hill at (6:40-6:43). Stop at Sour Hill & Arnold Branch at (6:43). Go to Hwy 21 North to Cannon Mines (6:45), Cannon Mines to CC Hwy to Hwy 21, Bus will arrive back at school at 7:15.

Route B Bus 1 -

Bus 1 will leave school at 6:30 turning north on 21. 6:35 bus will arrive at CC driving to E Highway (6:35-6:40). Take E Highway to Tiff Road (6:40). Turn left onto Tiff Road. Turn around and come back out to E Highway, turn left (6:54) Pinson Rd. and continue to Degonia Store (7:05). Then continue back to school arriving at 7:15.

Route C Bus 2 -

Bus 2 will leave school and turn south onto 21 at 6:35. Take 21 south to Sale Barn Rd (6:45-6:54). Turn around to Radio Station Rd. (6:56). Go through Radio Station Rd. to Highway E (6:56-6:59). Turn left onto E and go to 47 (7:00-7:05), then turn left onto 47 and continue back to 21. Then continue arriving back to school at 7:15.

Route D Bus 5 -

Bus 5 will leave school at 6:30 turning south on 21. Brown's Store (6:33). Travel to 47(6:35) and turn left. Travel onto 47 to Tiff: Rd. (6:46) and travel back to 47. Cadet Rd. and 47 (6:50) and turns onto E Hwy. (6:52). Picks up at the end of Powder Springs continuing to Bottom Diggins and back out to 47 (7:05) traveling to 21. Turns right to come back to school stopping at Villmer Rd at (7:03) Sansoucie Rd, Dart Rd, and Ambulance Shed (7:08). Then continue and arrive back at school at 7:15.
