## CONTRACT PERIOD

Vendors are cautioned that the items furnished must be at the prices submitted. All bid prices shall be firm for the period of August 1, 2019 to July 31, 2020. This contract may be terminated at any time by the School District upon sixty (60) days written notice should the School District determine that it is not in its best interest to continue the contract and /or the Vendor is not performing within the provisions and intent of this contract.

## EXPLANATION

**Fixed Bid** prices must stay firm for the period of August 01, 2020 to July 31, 2021.

**Escalator Bid** allows for market fluctuations. A letter on vendor letterhead is required for any fluctuation in price after acceptance of the successful bid. This letter must state the item(s) affected by a price change, the correct price(s), the price the item(s) will be, and the effective date of the price change. The vendor must provide reason for price change and proof of reason, if requested. The District must be notified a minimum of two weeks prior to any changes in pricing.

**Buy American:** As required by the **USDA Buy American provision**, the district will purchase, to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities or products for its nutrition program. "Domestic commodity" means an agricultural commodity that is produced in the United States of America, and "domestic product" means a food product that is processed in the United States of America substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States of America. See 7 C.F.R. §§ 210.21, 220.16.
