**September Model Guidance and Cougar Connections Objectives**  
**September :** Students will identify the meaning of **RESPONSIBILITY** and what it looks like at home, school, and in the community.

### **Kindergarten Objectives for Sept 28-Oct 2**

**Reading-** The students will be learning the following sight words: the, little, and, on, it, bus, Gus, black. The students will learn the -us chunk. The students will learn how to classify and categorize. The students will be identifying the following letters and their matching sounds: Tt, Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, Zz.

**Writing-** The students will learn how to write letters Tt, Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, Zz in correct letter formation.

**Math-** The students will be able to analyze, compare, and compose shapes (same shape, same size, roll, stack, and slide).

### **First Grade Objectives for Sept 28-Oct 2**

**Reading:** Students will use illustrations and details in a story to describe its character, setting, and events. Students will know and identify the consonant sounds f,ff,/f/,b, /b/, g, /g/ and the short i sound.

**Writing:** Students will use verbs to identify past, present, and future.

**Math:** Students will represent and solve problems involving additions and subtraction. Students will add and subtract within 20.

### **Second Grade Objectives for Sept 28-Oct 2**

**Reading-** Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. Identify the main topic of a multiparagraph text as well as the focus of specific paragraphs within the text.

**Writing-** Recognize and use declarative and interrogative sentences in reading, writing, and speaking.

**Spelling-** Associate the CVC short vowel pattern with doubling the final consonant before endings -ed and -ing, and associate the VCe long vowel pattern with dropping the final e before endings -ed and -ing. Spell base words with inflected endings -ed and -ing.

**Math-** Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction.

### **LIBRARY OBJECTIVES for Sept 28-Oct 2**

**KINDERGARTEN:** The students will learn about body fossils and trace fossils. We will watch a short **Bill Nye the Science Guy** film about fossils. The children will also create their own impression fossils using Model Magic and plastic dinosaurs. These impression footprint fossils will take some days to dry. Footprints are trace fossils; traces left behind by an animal, leaves, or shells.

**FIRST GRADE:** Students will be studying about pumpkins and plant parts using the Weekly Reader. The students will participate in a hands-on activity dissecting a pumpkin to study its inner parts!

**SECOND GRADE:** **Mercy Watson Goes for a Ride** will be the next book in our Chapter Snappers book study. Students will complete a Mercy Watson maze and create a car they would like to go for a ride in using Play-Doh.

### **PE OBJECTIVES for Sept 28-Oct 2**

**K-2 Students will be practicing locomotor skills. I can hop, I can jump, I can skip. Students will play Red light/Green light. We will begin going over components of kickball.**

### **MUSIC OBJECTIVES FOR MONTH OF SEPTEMBER**

**Kindergarten:** Use the voice 4 different ways in a song or chant. Demonstrate the four ways to use the voice & describe situations to use them in.

**First Grade:** Move to a meter of 3. Recognize that strong and weak beats help us count in meters of 2, 3, and 4. Listen and imitate rhythm patterns on instruments. Describe the purpose of bar lines. Recognize & perform ta, ti-ti, and shh. Create a composition

**Second Grade:**

- Identify quarter, beamed 8th, half notes and rests.
- Define duration
- Listen to, then write 2 measures of rhythm consisting of the above rhythms.
